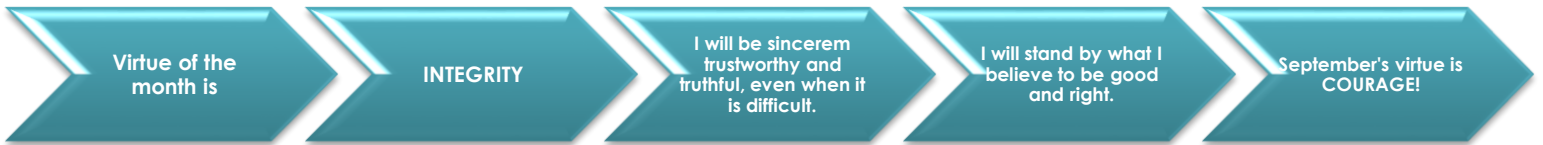

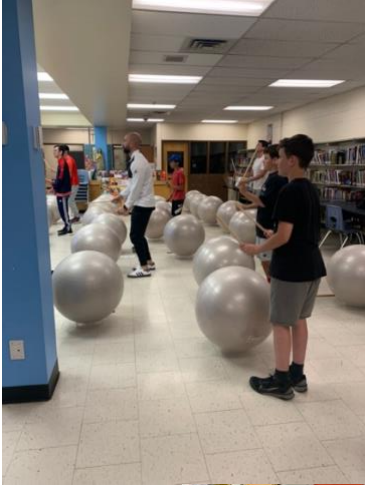
Ms. Bromley's Gr. 1 "Community"

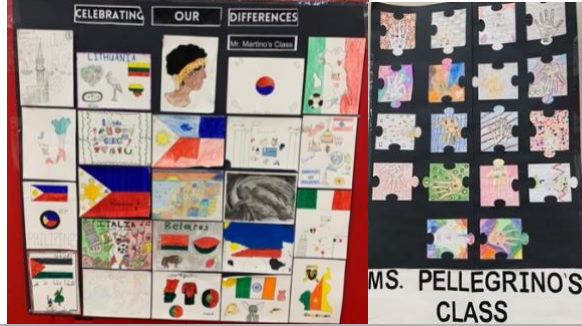
SPRING JUNIOR/INTERMEDIATE DIVERSITY SHOWCASE

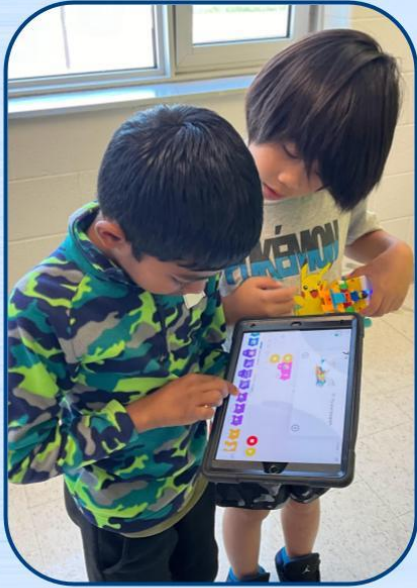
